SUNRISE VISITING POLICY (NURSING FACILITY)

- We request that visits be by appointment, as it helps administration keep track of visitors who are in the building
- COVID testing will be offered to any visitor that requests a test by appointment only
 - Testing is encouraged, especially for visitors who have not received full vaccinations, in order to help us prevent the spread of COVID in the nursing facility
- Visitors will be required to check in/out at the front desk, answer screening questions and have their temperature recorded, and perform hand hygiene prior to entering the resident's neighborhood
- Unvaccinated visitors will be required to wear face masks and eye protection at all times during their visit and maintain social distancing
- Fully vaccinated visitors:
 - Will not be required to wear face shields
 - May remove their face masks once they are in the visitation location, as long as all other people in the room are also fully vaccinated (including the resident)
 - Residents and their guests who have been vaccinated may choose to "touch" (hug, hold hands, etc.) their loved ones, per the CMS regulation, as long as they perform hand hygiene before and after
 - Vaccinated means a full two weeks has passed since the 2nd shot of a 2 shot vaccine or 2 weeks after a single shot vaccine
- Visitors will be required to stay in the resident's room during their visit and will not be allowed to move about the neighborhood
- Compassionate care visits can be made with Activities
- Visitors should be aware that the reception desk is staff from 8a-7p Monday through Friday, 8-4 Saturday and 10-4 on Sunday. If visitors are coming to the facility outside of these hours, they will need to be assisted by a staff member from one of the nursing neighborhoods to enter and exit the facility.

VISITING PLANS FOR FOUNTAIN VIEW ASSISTED LIVING

The Visiting Plan for Fountain View Assisted Living will be similar to that of the nursing facility (above).

- We request that visits will be by appointment, including compassionate care visits.
- Visitors will be encouraged to test prior to visiting, in order to prevent spreading COVID to the Assisted Living residents
- Visitors will be required to check in and out, wear appropriate PPE (masks), perform hand hygiene as required, and maintain social distancing (the guidelines from the nursing facility apply equally to the assisted living – see above)
- Visitors will be required to stay in the resident's room during their visit and will not be allowed to move about the neighborhood
